Water Stewardship Assurance Services (WSAS) plans to conduct an AWS certification audit of British American Tobacco Kenya plc's manufacturing site at 08 Likoni Road, Industrial Area, Nairobi.

The audit aims to assess the site's compliance with the Alliance for Water Stewardship Standard (AWS) V2.0 and is scheduled to take place from 20th to 22nd June 2022.

- Audit planning and document review, on site assessment of compliance to the AWS standard V2.0,
- Report describing the evaluation process and findings, forming the basis for the certification decision, and
- The certification decision.
